

Don't push yourself

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT (SWM) ANNOUNCES COLLECTION AND FACILITY SCHEDULE INTERRUPTIONS IN BERYL AFTERMATH



Tuesday, July 9, 2024 Monday's garbage and heavy tree waste will be collected. Storm debris collections will resume. All six Neighborhood Depositories will reopen, but all other facilities will remain closed. Recycling and yard waste services will be suspended for the remainder of the week and will be collected on your next regularly scheduled collection day.

Additionally, SWM will conduct city-wide damage assessments from Hurricane Beryl.
