

#### **Budget Summary**

**Current Status:** 

- Estimated ITRP budget is \$1.36B
- This reflects the efficiency opportunity to include additional scope, as well as traffic mitigations measures, and the recent sudden inflation and global market impacts.
- ITRP has managed and mitigated a significant number of impacts, such as:
  - Innovative strategies to combat inflation have been successful (advanced purchasing of materials, storing large quantities of materials, receiving delivery earlier than needed, avoiding highly volatile materials like stainless steel, etc.).
  - ITRP has absorbed \$6M in escalation within current budget - no additional funding needed
- Continuous monitoring and tracking of market impacts on ITRP will continue.




























