
Office of Emergency Communications Staffing Needs

Important Considerations

Chief manages the whole floor.

Senior Captains directly supervise the 12 other positions.


Under present conditions, Senior Captains are being used to monitor active fires. This scenario takes away from the recommended span of control for emergency communications.

Communication Captains


Monitor the channels

Are now being sent to 2-11 fires to assist the Incident Commander on the scene of a fire.

An Increase in calls needs additional support

Approximately 9,000 emergency calls per day are processed at the HEC.


The volume of emergency calls can easily double during times of inclement weather or special social/sporting events in the Greater Houston area.

Staffing 24/7 Positions

- The current Houston Fire Department formula for staffing 24/7 positions is:
- 4.66 x (P)
- (P) Being the number of positions staffed
- 4.66 *x* 16 = 75
