Heat Emergency Plans

Purpose

Prolonged Heat may be deemed a health emergency by HHD

Trigger

- Reach/Exceed Temperature of 103° or Heat Index of 108°
- 2 or more consecutive days

Heat Emergency Plans (cont'd) Rhythm Planning (Weekends*)

*Cooling Center coordination is primarily for weekends. City facilities can adjust hours during weekdays. Other businesses can also be utilized as cooling centers as well.

- Monday Monitor upcoming weekend weather
- IF threshold / trigger is expected:

Wednesday - Send stand-by notice (via email)

• Have Departments / Partners ready their locations and staff

<u>Thursday</u>- Meeting invite to Heat Emergency Departments / Partners <u>Friday</u>- Hold Heat Emergency Plan Meeting

- Department / Partner *updates*: Weather, Locations, Staffing, Logistics, Concerns
- Coordinate of efforts to finalize plans




