Sec. 21-236. Definitions.

The following words, terms and phrases, whenever used in this article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, unless the context of their usage clearly indicates a different meaning:

<u>Public pedestrian walkway (plaza) means a public street right-of-way that has been permanently closed to vehicular traffic but is open to pedestrian passage.</u>

Smoking means inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying any lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or <u>any</u> other lighted tobacco product in <u>any manner or in any form, plant material, or other combustible substance</u>.

Sec. 21-237.1 Prohibition of smoking in public pedestrian walkways.

Smoking shall be prohibited in all public pedestrian walkways.

Sec. 21-244. Posting of signs.

(a) The owner, operator, manager, or other person in control of a public place, <u>public pedestrian walkway</u>, or place of employment shall clearly and conspicuously post "No Smoking" signs or the international "No Smoking" symbol (consisting of a pictorial representation of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a red bar across it) in every <u>public</u> place and place of employment where smoking is prohibited by this article.
