

**Sec. 21-236. Definitions.**

The following words, terms and phrases, whenever used in this article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, unless the context of their usage clearly indicates a different meaning:

Public pedestrian walkway (plaza) means a public street right-of-way that has been permanently closed to vehicular traffic but is open to pedestrian passage.

Smoking means inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying any lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or any other lighted tobacco product ~~in any manner or in any form,~~ plant material, or other combustible substance.

**Sec. 21-237.1 Prohibition of smoking in public pedestrian walkways.**

Smoking shall be prohibited in all public pedestrian walkways.

**Sec. 21-244. Posting of signs.**

(a) The owner, operator, manager, or other person in control of a public place, public pedestrian walkway, or place of employment shall clearly and conspicuously post "No Smoking" signs or the international "No Smoking" symbol (consisting of a pictorial representation of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a red bar across it) in every ~~public place and place of employment~~ where smoking is prohibited by this article.
