

Overall Project Timeline
















- Present to City Council May


Conservation Districts Focus Group

Purpose

Will draft framework for Conservation Districts program

Progress

- Began work in October
- 5 meetings so far
- Wrapping up on the framework by March

- Density & Affordability
- Access & Multimodal Options

Residential Buffering

Purpose

Address the buffering ordinance concerns due to high density development adjacent to single family residential developments

Progress

- Discussed the concerns we heard from public via the engagement tool
- Conducted 40 site visits and studied 6 cities to find solutions
- Met with Technical Advisory Group to discuss potential solutions
- Present amendment concepts in the next meeting
