







METRORapid Inner Katy Project

- Regionally significant and high priority project in voter-approved METRONext Plan.
- Awarded CMAQ Funding.
- Frequent, fast and reliable Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) service connecting Downtown and Uptown.
- Elevated two-way exclusive guideway for BRT and Regional Express buses along south side of I-10 West.
- Shared exclusive lane with METRORail on Capitol and Rusk streets in Downtown to EaDo.
- Enhanced regional access to jobs, schools, recreation and social opportunities.










Regional Express Bus Network



Locally Preferred Alternative Inner Katy Segment: Northwest Transit Center to I-45 at Downtown




Stakeholder Engagement: TxDOT

- TxDOT initiatives along I-10:
 - Drainage Improvements Projects
 - Katy Managed Lanes
 - White Oak Bayou
 - NHHIP
- **METRO** is evaluating design concept alternatives that consider potential future TxDOT's Katy Managed Lane Project
- METRO's goal:
 - Identify and execute on collaboration opportunities with TxDOT (e.g., White Oak Bayou Project)
 - Place Inner Katy into revenue service by 2027
 - Provide a BRT alternative for commuters prior to any future construction by TxDOT (congestion relief)
