

Sales Tax Revenues






HRT Overview (cont)

Over 90% of workers on the project are either from Houston or have relocated to Houston

- 980 Total Workers, 170,000 Hrs/Mo
- 400 HRT Craft labor, all local hires
- ~350 Subcontractors employees, **~90% local**
- 230+ Partner employees
- 58 Local hires
- 117 Relocated to Houston
- 55 Temporary assignment
- Peak over 1000 Workers 2012


91% of the 980 Workers are from the greater Houston area.



Project S/DBE Demographics Increased participation

- 269 Unique S/DBE firms 1st & 2nd tier
- -95% Local,
- 53% are DBE's
- -31% are Woman owned
- 555 total contracts
- HRT has agreed to pay first tier SBE's early
- \$285 Million under contract, \$146 Million paid
- Current Plan: \$295 Million, exceeds Metro/HRT Contract goals

\$295M SBE Plan exceeds Contract Goal by \$40M





Time Incident Rate


