initial storm hazards: ice, snow, and roads






#### **WINTER STORM URI**

#### **STORM IMPACTS**

impact to surface water treatment plants

impact to groundwater system

impact to drinking water distribution system

impact to our customers

boil water notice

messaging- not dripping taps



## IMPACT TO SURFACE WATER TREATMENT PLANTS

#### impact

treatment chemistry is more difficult in colder water temperatures

damage to some chemical feed systems was persistent throughout plants







#### IMPACT TO GROUNDWATER SYSTEM

#### challenges

54 groundwater plants across a large area of the city

#### impact

significant damage to process water lines and appurtenances



### IMPACT TO DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

#### impact

significant increase in water main breaks throughout the system most notably on service mains and private laterals






Do NOT drip your faucets, this will cause low water pressure to our City. Instead, open cabinet doors under sinks to make sure they stay warm.

- pipes

#### mitigation

29 facility full-service maintenance contract

#### challenges

disinfecting chemicals and supply chain

#### mitigation

Evaluating multiple non-local vendors







# REGION WIDE POWER OUTAGE PREPAREDNESS & RESILIENCE

#### challenges

on-site back-up power

#### mitigation

- generators
- microgrids and alternative energy
- partnering with CenterPoint



#### **TECHNOLOGY PREPAREDNESS & RESILIENCE**

#### challenges

- field systems (i.e., SCADA) and network redundancy
- remote employee support

#### mitigation

- establish multiple network paths and "cloud" storage
- increase utilization of One Drive, air cards and cell phone tethering



### CUSTOMER ACCOUNT SERVICES

#### challenges

- develop process for shutoffs and reinstatement of water post storm
- refine process for addressing extraordinary events significantly impacting water bills

#### mitigation

winter storm relief ordinance adopted







#### **PROCUREMENT**

#### challenges

 warehouse not configured for staging and distribution for a large-scale emergency

#### mitigation

 establish warehousing for larger scale staging, distribution and storage




#### GOVERNMENT RELATIONS

#### mitigation

develop searchable web based interactive map
