






52 inches of rain in a 5-day period resulting in over 300,000 households impacted and over \$2.5B in damaged city facilities and infrastructure.





Create a plan for "Lily Pads" across Houston that are intended to operate before, during, and after disturbances, making them steady-state assets for local emergency management and city officials.


