#### System Overview

HFD implemented the ImageTrend Patient Care Reporting System in 2012 and the Fire Reporting System in 2019. The HFD BaseStation, Hazmat, Hydrants, Cardiac Arrest teams, ETHAN (Electronic Telehealth and Navigation) and COH Finance utilize ImageTrend as well. ImageTrend's reporting capabilities are extensive and utilized daily. Nearly every HFD employee utilizes ImageTrend regularly.

#### Vendor Overview

ImageTrend: Leading ePCR (Electronic Patient Care Report) vendor since 1998, expanded scope in Fire Reporting subsequently. Product is customizable and integrates with Houston Emergency Center's Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), Health Information Exchanges, HFD's Billing Vendor, HFD Staffing and other reporting dashboards (Cardiac Arrest Registry to Enhance Survival (CARES), Biospatial, etc).
