

#### eDiscovery matters

- When a party fails to adequately collect, preserve or produce documents, courts may impose various sanctions including:
  - Instruction to the jury that the lost data affirmatively would have provided information relevant to the claims and defenses;
  - Offending party precluded from offering certain evidence to support its position
  - Injured party would be able to re-depose witnesses at the offending party's costs
  - Monetary sanctions, such as the injured party's attorneys' fees or costs
  - Instruction to the jury to conclude that the destroyed evidence would have hurt the party who destroyed it and helped the injured party
  - Order prohibiting further discovery by the spoliator
  - Dismissing the case or awarding a default judgment in favor of the injured party
  - Limiting the amount of damages recoverable
  - Striking pleadings

#### **Existing eDiscovery Software**

- The City's current system has been in place since April 2016. It is licensed to process up to 400 GB total for active cases. This has proven insufficient for our needs. With the explosion of digital technology, the City needs a system that can handle 1 2TB of data.
- The City's current system relies heavily on the technical support specialists to operate and manage it, rather than empowering attorneys and staff to manage smaller matters and cases.
- The City's current system does not include access to advanced technical features that will streamline and make document review and processing more efficient, such as relying on artificial intelligence to find and group like documents/data.
