RMS Timeline

- May 2009 Current Tiburon RMS Contract Start
- May 2023 Current Tiburon RMS Contract Ends
 - Seeking One Year Extension to allow for transition to new RMS
- April 2022 COH published RFP for new RMS
 - Requirements based on HPD needs and the Integrated Justice Information Systems (IJIS) Standard Functional Specifications for Law Enforcement RMS
 - Bid Closed July 2022
- Aug 2022 thru Jan 2023 Bid responses evaluated



Functional Goals

- Provide a turn-key law enforcement RMS that supports state and federal compliance regulations with a proven track record of large agencies (approximately 5300 sworn officers).
- Highly configurable, user-friendly interfaces with such features as field validation, smart-suggest, and context-sensitive help.
- Utilizes the most cost-effective cloud storage available
- Provides for comprehensive statistical and user-defined reporting
- Interfaces with various HPD external systems to minimize duplicate data entry, improve data quality, and enable data accessibility between disparate systems.



System Requirements

- System design includes mobile application for HPD smartphone use
- Adhere to current industry standards.
- Employ an IT design that utilizes current technology, adheres to HPD's IT technology standards, and accommodates technological improvements.
- Proven track record of reliability with a system design that is inherently fault tolerant.
- The RMS shall comply with all applicable local, state, and federal confidentiality requirements including the current FBI CJIS policy.
