Subject: Inspection of Woodridge Village, Perry Homes Development

Findings:

- > Tracking from construction site entrance on Woodland Hills Drive
- Tracking from median on Woodland Hills Drive
- Light sediment found in Elm Grove Subdivision, heaviest in the northern areas
- Four plus inches of sediment removed from end of Village Springs Drive
- Best Management Practices require repair / maintenance

Actions: Discussed findings with Perry Homes' representative

- Remove thick sediment from Village Springs Drive
- They agreed to remove dirt tracked from the site onto Woodland Hills Drive
- Discuss with contractors the importance of not tracking mud / sediment from the site
- Sweep the impacted streets in Elm Grove Subdivision
- Repair / Maintain their Best Management Practices
- They are open to additional findings and suggestions
