Federal Grant from HUD:

The \$13,542,193 in funding from HUD is broken down into the following activities:

- HCDD has designated the remaining \$8,802,425 in NSP Funds to the National Farm Workers Service Center (NFWSC) Multi Family Unit for rehabilitation of the Zollie Scales Apartments. This project will benefit individuals who are currently earning less than 50% AMI. This project will satisfy the set-aside requirement. Funds have been fully obligated. The property currently scheduled the second week in October.
- HCDD has awarded \$3,385,549 in NSP funds for single-family rehabilitation. Funding will be available to provide home ownership to families earning less than 120% AMI. HCDD has designated four non-profit organizations to acquire, rehabilitate and sell foreclosed properties at an affordable price. HCDD has obligated \$3,385,549 in DRGR for single family housing. We held a training session to educate the participating 501(c) participants on NSP and HUD regulations. This project is anticipated to generate program income. All properties are under a Purchase Sales Agreement with five homes purchased and 35 closings scheduled.
- \$1,354,219.00 has been designated for Admin; all Admin funds have been obligated. The current status of the Houston Federal NSP Grant is as follows:
