

Data and technology consulting scope of work July 25, 2018

Summary:

The City of Houston Housing and Community Development Department (HCD) is responsible for overseeing an equitable and data-driven housing recovery post Hurricane Harvey. Immediately after the storm, HCD identified technology and data as strategic areas of investment that will help the City understand Harvey's impact and coordinate the recovery effort.

Shortly after Hurricane Harvey, HCD hired January Advisors to provide data and technology consulting services. It is through this experience that we have a deep understanding of the HCD's goals, assets, capacity, and plans in these early stages of disaster recovery.

We have identified key activities and deliverables for the 2018-2019 fiscal year that include web and digital strategy, continued analysis of disaster data, assistance with data visualization, general IT strategy, and project management assistance.

Scope:

- Continue disaster analytics project assistance. This includes working with other HCD consultants
 to ensure successful and relevant data deliverables, and working with community partners to orient
 them on HCD's data assets. <u>COH stakeholders: Alfred Henson, Derek Sellers, Angela Simon, Steven
 David, Tom McCasland.</u>
- Develop data visualizations using newly acquired disaster analytics data. These visualizations and maps can compliment HCD's community engagement sessions, they can be formatted for social media, and they can be embedded into HCD's website. <u>COH stakeholders: Sarah Labowitz, Angela</u> Simon, Alfred Henson.
- Develop website for Housing recovery using Wordpress. Following a user-centered design process, we will develop and launch a site that helps HCD communicate recovery progress and comply with HUD requirements. This task includes all activities related to the design, development, and deployment of the website, as well as working with stakeholders in HCD and HITS to ensure compliance with City procedures, and training for City staff to maintain and update the site after deployment. COH stakeholders: Sarah Labowitz, Valerie Watson, Bob Nowak, Jesse Bounds, Melissa Ragsdale Darragh.
- Assist with multifamily data analysis to help achieve the vision in HCD's draft local action plan.
 HCD identified renters as a particularly vulnerable and hard to reach population. We will assist HCD

with data analysis to uncover new ideas for policy and engagement with renters, property owners, and surrounding communities. *COH stakeholders: Angela Simon*.

- Capacity building for HCD GIS team. The GIS team is very active and has deep subject matter
 expertise in housing and disaster recovery. We will meet with the team every 2-3 weeks and help
 communicate their capacity and impact. <u>COH stakeholders</u>; <u>Alfred Henson</u>, <u>Tom McCasland</u>.
- Assist HCD with technology solution evaluation. During the course of the next year, HCD will have
 the opportunity to evaluate and procure technology systems and devices. We will be available as
 subject matter experts on topics related to data, smart cities, and emerging technologies, and
 assist in the procurement process when needed. <u>COH stakeholders: Tom McCasland.</u>
- Assist HCD with recruiting for key data and IT positions. As needed, provide guidance on recruitment and hiring to support departmental data and IT needs.
- Miscellaneous data strategy coordination. This includes identifying and classifying various data sources within HCD and its vendors, assisting with legal questions about data licensing, replicating an analysis, writing data requests, and other small tasks. <u>COH stakeholders: Tom McCasland.</u>

Project administration:

We will provide a monthly stakeholder briefing either in person or on the phone, where we give summary of our monthly activities and progress towards defined milestones. We will also provide a written summary alongside our invoice.

Time:

This scope of work covers the twelve month period from July 2018 to June 2019. Excluding the website deliverable, the remaining work product and administrative time will be structured not to exceed an average of 20 hours per month.
