is \$155,067,147.78. The Round 2 Infrastructure (or non-Housing) grant was originally listed as \$26,148,986.00. The Single Family contract has been amended six times, the Multifamily contract has been amended five times, and the Infrastructure contract has been amended three times.

HCDD proposes a sixth amendment to the Multifamily contract and a fourth amendment to the Infrastructure contract to move \$2,396,294 in funds from the Multifamily contract to the Infrastructure contract. While this changes the totals for both these contracts, the total amount

awarded to HCDD remains the same. Here are the proposed budgets for these two contracts:
