In the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022 (Public Law 117-103) (the Act), U.S. Congress made Community Project Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending (CPF) awards available, and projects were identified in the annual appropriations legislation. The City of Houston (The City) was named the recipient of one grant award from the U.S. Department of Labor for the EmPowering Solar Jobs, which is a workforce development program focused on preparing and accelerating STEM career opportunities for residents without college degrees and living in underresourced and underserved neighborhoods. The program will build capacity by supporting local industry training providers, which may include Houston Community College and Lone Star College, to create an employment pipeline for program graduates. The program will provide education certificate courses for solar installation and career preparation wraparound services.
