**Kingwood & Clear Lake Recycling Centers** 

These are unstaffed City of Houston facilities where residents may drop-off their recyclables. Residents are to place recyclables in the appropriate boxes at the sites. Boxes are available for the following recyclable categories: Paper, Cardboard, Glass, Plastic Containers, and Metal Cans. Residents are encouraged to separate items before arriving to make their visit more efficient.

# **YES!** Recycle

PAPER: newspaper, office paper, magazines, junk mail, envelopes, postcards, ad inserts, catalogs,

telephone books. Cartons from juice, milk, soup, etc. are to be placed in the paper box. Both

aseptic and gable top cartons are accepted.

- **NO** tissue paper, wrapping paper, toilet paper, paper towels or tissues.

CARDBOARD: boxes (flattened) please ensure boxes are clean of any food; AND empty of all packing

materials ie Styrofoam, plastic air bags, plastic wrap, Kraft paper. Boxes in boxes and

cardboard dividers are OK.

glass bottles and jars, clear, green and brown. Please ensure bottles and jars are empty, and

lids have been removed.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS: plastic containers such as bottles, jugs and tubs #1-5 and #7, that are emptied and rinsed.

Examples include soda bottles, milk jugs, detergent bottles, yogurt cups, margarine tubs.

- **NO** large plastic items such as toys, garden tools, or furniture.

- **NO** flexible plastic of any kind including plastic bags, shrink wrap, tarps, snack bags.

**METAL CANS:** aluminum and bimetal cans that are rinsed and drained. Examples: drink cans/bottles, soup

cans, vegetable cans, fruit cans, pet food cans, coffee cans.

#### **ELECTRONIC RECYCLING COLLECTION**

The City of Houston offers electronics recycling once a month at both these locations. The Kingwood event is the first (1st) Saturday of each month; and the Clear Lake event is the second (2nd) Saturday of each month. Events are for residents only, no businesses.
