

Memorial Park FAQs

- Location: Memorial Park Golf Course
- Event Management: Astros Golf Foundation in partnership with the Houston Parks and Recreation Department. Additional details may be found on the <u>Houston Open website</u>, the <u>Houston Municipal Golf website</u>, the <u>City of Houston website</u>, and the <u>Houston Parks and</u> <u>Recreation Department</u>.
- Memorial Park, the Seymour Lieberman Trail and the Clay Family Eastern Glades will remain open to the public during the tournament hours, however, certain areas of the park adjacent to the golf course may be closed or subject to detours to enhance public safety. There will be NO Tennis Court, Volleyball, Baseball or Soccer Field, Eastern Glades Picnic Pavilion, Playground, MP greenspace, Swimming Pool, or Fitness Center rentals/permits during the week tournament impact dates.

 - Park Access
 - Restricted access Thursday Sunday (March 27th-30th), starting at 11:59 PM Wednesday, March 26th.
 - Parking
 - Available Monday Wednesday (March 24th 26th)
 - Restricted access Thursday Sunday (March 27th- March 30th)





FAQ Continued

Memorial Park Conservancy is asking the public to be aware of the following closure impacts:

Memorial Park, including Seymour Lieberman Trail and Clay Family Eastern Glades, will remain open to the public during the tournament, however, access to the Park will be limited. Onsite parking, sports and field rentals will not be available.

The Cullen Running Trails Center will continue to operate during its regular business hours on these days.

WHAT'S IMPACTED?

All Memorial Parking lots will be closed to the public from March 27-30. If visiting the Park on these days, visitors should walk, bike, ride share or take METRO.

*Please note, the parking lots at Memorial Park Golf Course, Vale-Asche Playground, Sports Complex (East & West) and Tennis Center will also be closed March 23-26. The parking lots at the Fitness Center, Clay Family Eastern Glades, Picnic Loop and Running Complex will remain open during those days.

Street Closures from March 27-30:

- East and West Memorial Loop Drive
- Westcott entrance at Memorial Loop Drive
- Arnot Street from East Memorial Loop Drive to Crestwood Drive

NO park-user or tournament parking allowed in the following neighborhoods:

- Camp Logan
- Crestwood
- Glen Cove

Parking restrictions will be strictly enforced.

HOW DO I GET TO THE PARK?

Park users are encouraged to utilize rideshare services or the Houston Metro bus to access the Park.

Designated rideshare drop-off locations will be established for the tournament, and Metro will maintain its usual bus routes.

The Metro Bus Line #20 travels east and west along Memorial Drive, with several stops within the Park. Visit the Metro website for more information.

Visitors and runners at Memorial Park are encouraged to seize the chance to explore one of the Houston Parks and Recreation Department's 381 additional parks and 196 miles of trails.

- Event Parking Plan March 23rd March 30th
 - All Memorial Park Parking North of Memorial Drive (event zone) is available for tournament parking permit only.
 - No Tournament Parking in the Land Bridge and Prairie Lot, or in the Neighborhood (Impact Zone highlighted in YELLOW on the Exhibit Map).
 - Tournament VIP Parking is designated in **RED** highlight on the Impact Zone Map.
 - Additional VIP ONLY parking located in the Arboretum, South Picnic, Running trail parking lot from Thursday through Sunday (March 27th- March 30th)
 - Volunteer and Staff Parking
 - Is at One Riverway, 777 S Post Oak Lane Houston, TX 77056
 - Rideshare located along Memorial Drive
 - East Bound Lanes (Exhibit B)
 - West Bound Lanes (Exhibit A)
 - See Exhibit C for 7th green (rideshare) entrance
 - Digital Sign boards are placed along memorial Loop drive notifying public of street closures

Impact Dates: Sunday, March 23, 2025 – Sunday, March 30, 2025

- Houston Public Works, Transportation and Drainage Operations will distribute "Emergency No Parking" signs and Traffic Cones along the following streets to secure a safety lane for emergency vehicles to access the park:
 - West Lane of Crestwood between Arnot and Rains Way (to dead end)
 - West lane of Haskell between Arnot and Durford St and,
 - North lane of Arnot between Haskell and Crestwood.
 - Taggart/Minola between Arnot and Coppage
 - East and West Curb Lanes of Wescott St feeder between Durford St and Memorial Loop Dr.
 - "Parking By Permit Only Towing Enforced" New Process: yard signs will be placed by <u>residents</u> and throughout the neighborhoods of Crestwood, Camp Logan and Glen Cove starting Thursday, March 27th through Sunday, March 30th
 - MOSE will deliver yard signs to Neighborhood Associations on (TBD) for resident pick up and distribution
 - MOSE will also install signs at street intersections
 - At event conclusion yards can be recycled
 - New signs will be created and distributed next year with updated information including new Command Post phone number
 - The Houston Open Tournament has created a "Temporary Resident Street Parking Only" Hang Tag Permit dated for Thursday, March 27th thru Sunday, March 30th.
 - <u>This permit will be distributed to residents through the</u> <u>Neighborhood Civic Clubs.</u>
 - All vehicles parking on public streets within the Impact Zone must have the temporary parking permit displayed hanging from rearview mirror.




